







## NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MEETING NOTES

### Neighborhood Traffic Management Program

October 29, 2018, 7:00 - 9:00 PM

**Attendance-** 21 residents were in attendance. Town staff included Thomas Valdriz, Andrew Dillard, and Majid Hafezieh from the Transportation Division.

**Purpose of Meeting-** This meeting was the third meeting between the Town of Danville and the Rancho San Ramon Heights Neighborhood. The first two meetings were conducted at the Town Offices on September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017. The purpose of the neighborhood meetings was to discuss the concerns of the neighborhood and the Town of Danville Neighborhood Traffic Management Program. From these meetings, neighbors discussed their traffic safety concerns, discussed potential solutions for addressing the traffic safety concerns, and requested that the Town develop a series of traffic calming proposals for the following streets:

1. El Rincon Road
2. Via Hermosa

**Review of the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP)** - The NTMP is the Town's traffic calming program, which aims to manage inappropriate vehicular speeds and volumes through educational, enforcement, and/or engineering measures so that their negative impacts on residents, pedestrians, bicyclists, and schools are minimized.

#### **Review of the NTMP Process -**

1. Application
2. Data Collection & Analysis
3. Traffic Calming Plan is Developed through Neighborhood Meetings (Current)
4. Neighborhood Petition
5. Town Council Approval
6. Implementation
7. Monitor Effectiveness
8. Concerns Addressed

## **Next Steps-**

1. Town Staff will work with residents living at parcels near the Via Hermosa / Diablo Road and El Rincon Road / Camino Tassajara intersections to place one speed limit sign and one “No Through Traffic / Residential Area” sign combo at each entrance into the neighborhood.
2. Town Staff will approach residents within the immediate vicinity of any proposed locations for speed lumps.
3. Based on feedback received on the speed lumps, Town Staff will develop a Traffic Calming Plan Proposal for El Rincon Road and Via Hermosa. Potential elements may include:
  - a. Keep Kids Alive- Drive 25 Sign(s)
  - b. Speed Lumps & Advisory Signs
  - c. Pedestrian Warning Advisory Sign(s)
  - d. All-Way Stop at the Via Hermosa / El Rincon Road / Hermosa Ct Intersection.
    - i. Stop Signs & Pavement Markings
    - ii. Centerline Details
    - iii. Yield Sign & Pavement Markings
    - iv. Lane Use Arrows
    - v. Channelizing Lines
4. Action items for residents:
  - a. Create petition(s) using language referencing the Traffic Calming Plan with the guidance and support of Town Staff.
  - b. Inform the Town of any overgrown vegetation causing visibility or other safety issues.

## **Summary-**

The Town will install advisory and speed limit signs, finalize the Traffic Calming Plan Proposal, and will approach residents within the immediate vicinity of any proposed speed lumps. Once these proposals are finalized, the Town will reconvene the neighborhood to review in advance of the petition process. The neighborhood will then be tasked with creating a petition. The petition will have to be signed by the neighborhood before the Town Council will approve them. Once approved, the Town will implement these enhancements as proposed, and will monitor the effectiveness of the measures until the concerns have been addressed.
